Family Coastal Capers

Arran's coastline is perfect for inquisitive wildlife watching families! On this half day activity we will explore a child friendly stretch of coastline and find out more about the creatures that inhabit it. Discover rockpools, look for footprints on the beach, and watch seals and even otters at the same time.

Essential information:

- Tracking and casting footprints
- Otter watching
- Rockpooling

Materials for activities including nets buckets etc, spotting scope and some binoculars are available to borrow if you don't have your own pair.
