Otter Discovery Trail: Info Sheet

Otters are one of Britain's best loved mammals and we are lucky on Arran to have several families and individuals that can be watched around the coast. On this half day trip we visit some of the best locations around the island to view them. Whilst sightings are never guaranteed, we will also be looking for otter signs such as tracks and spraint.- a great opportunity hone your skills and find out how to spot them! These coastal locations are also great for other wildlife and there is always plenty to see and enjoy. Because of the shy nature of these animals, maximum group size is limited to four.

Essential information:

We will visit locations where short walks will take us to excellent locations for viewing otters and other wildlife. The walks are not strenuous, but footpaths can be muddy or rough. Locations vary depending on the prevailing weather and tide conditions, and based on the latest information about otter activity.

What is provided:

Transport in my vehicle is available between locations and enables the opportunity to view wildlife on route. Some binoculars area available to borrow if you don't have your own pair.

What to bring:

Walking footwear with a good grip.
Warm clothing layers
Waterproof jacket (and trousers if weather is poor)
Snack and a drink
Warm hat and gloves
Personal medication and sunscreen

Cost: £25 per person.
